Following multi-agency consultation the HSCB revised Threshold of Need framework and guidance has been published today (Friday 4th May 2018)

The guidance has been designed to assist all whose work brings them into contact with children, young people and their families (including an unborn child) to identify the most appropriate level of support required to ensure that children are kept safe and grow up in circumstances that allow them to achieve their best outcomes.

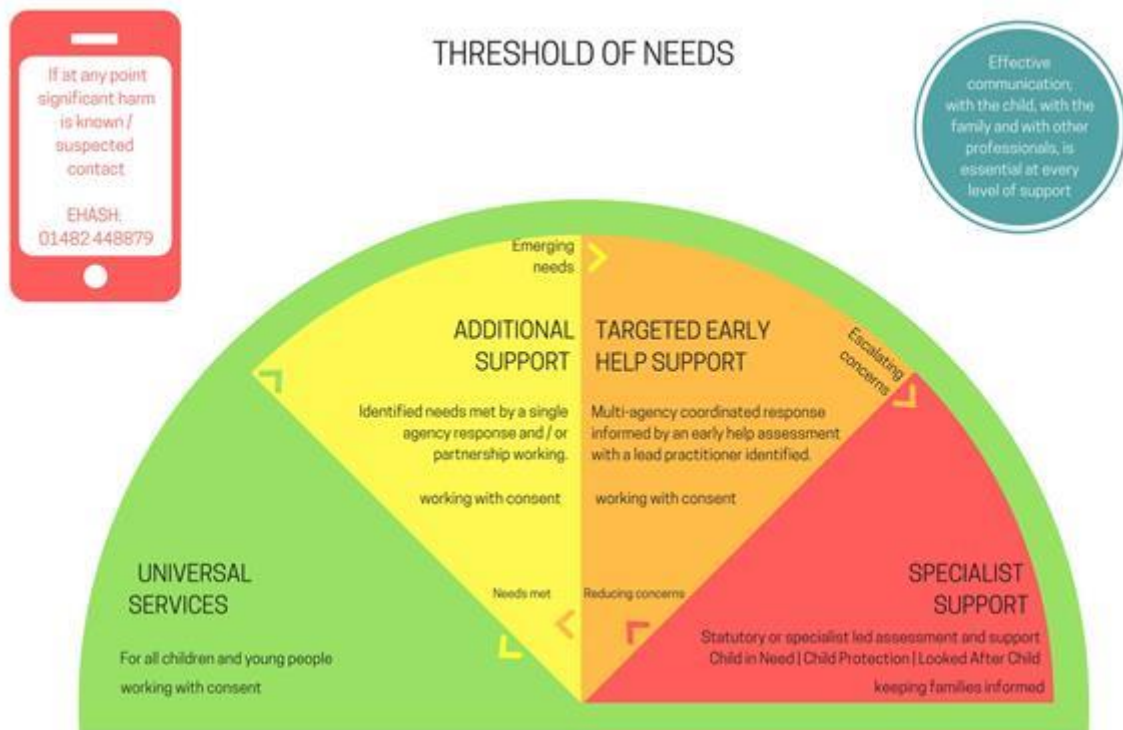
