Our Teams

We have opportunities in the following areas

Our Assessment Teams - completing our first social care assessments, working closely with our integrated front door Early Help and Safeguarding Hub (EHASH)

Our Locality Teams - working with children who have been assessed as requiring longer term support and intervention (our Children in Need, Child Protection and Court Work)

Our Children Looked After (CLA) - working with our children looked after longer term, driving permanence for all children and young people in care

Will You Feel Rewarded?

At Hull we recognise the commitment from Social Workers who work above and beyond in their dedication and commitment to the children and families that we support. We have invested in learning and development allowing staff to excel and achieve their potential.

We offer a competitive rate of pay and in addition to this all registered Social Workers will have the cost of their Social Work England Registration paid and Social Workers in eligible roles will receive an additional payment of £1,750 after each year of service, there's an annual leave entitlement of up to 29 days with 8 bank holidays, 2 additional statutory days and an additional concessionary day, as well as an excellent Local Government Pension Scheme for you to take advantage of. Flexible working options are also available with a hybrid approach to working currently in place.

Learning and Development

Here at Hull we are developing and nurturing a culture that puts our children and young people at the heart of everything we do. We have recently implemented the signs of safety approach which has empowered our workforce to work together with children, young people and their families to find solutions to challenges, and to be honest and respectful.

All staff joining Hull will receive signs of safety training alongside other learning and development such as our Practice Learning Programme, which is delivered by Research In Practice. We also have dedicated Practice Leads supporting practitioners on the ground, developing their skills and empowering them within their work and confidence.
